Students who have multiple rehearsals may arrive in time for their first rehearsal and remain in the gym until their final rehearsal is completed. Parents are asked to pick their students up promptly at the end of their rehearsal time so that we may prepare for the evening event. The RIM Club will have snacks and drinks available for purchase throughout the day.

We invite all friends and family to attend this concert in support of the Rowland Unified School District Instrumental Music Program. Tickets will be available for purchase at the door that evening. A \$15.00 family ticket may be used to admit up to five members of a student's immediate family, including siblings under the age of 18. Additional tickets may be purchased for \$5.00 each. Boys - Button-down shirt and slacks

Girls – Blouse and slacks, dress or skirt (below the knee when sitting) (A white polo band shirt or school uniform pants or skirt are a good choice for boys or girls).
