



Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) Information

In 2013-14, California adopted a new K-12 funding law called **Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF)**, developed to assist schools with focusing resources on student success. As part of the LCFF, Rowland Unified School District (RUSD) must develop, adopt and annually update a three-year **Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP)** that meets the educational priorities of our community. The LCAP includes input from parents and the community. The plan must address District goals and specific actions to achieve the goals for all students and specific subgroups of students (low-income students, English learners and foster youth), as well as address the eight state priority areas listed below. RUSD's 2013-14 Plan was adopted by the Board of Education on June 24, 2014 and the plan was reviewed and approved by the Los Angeles County Office of Education. *RUSD's LCAP and more information can be found at www.RowlandSchools.org with helpful links to additional materials and videos.*
