1. **Question:** I wanted to request an extension to this project by 2 weeks?

**Answer:** The project due date will be extended from **November 23, 2021 to December 1, 2021, no later than 9:00 A.M.**

**Revised Proposal Deadline.** All Proposals must be received on or before **December 1, 2021** not later than **9:00 A.M.**

2. **Question:** We presume all of these will be DSA projects would you please confirm.

**Answer:** Yes, this project is a DSA project.

3. **Question:** In many cases the locations that were proposed were adjacent to baseball diamonds and soccer fields. This makes them very susceptible to impact damage. Could we propose alternate locations that would be much less prone to damage?

**Answer:** We prefer the locations indicated, but alternate locations may be submitted.

4. **Question:** In some locations the distance to the points of interconnection were very long and would result in heavy line losses. Could we propose aggregating solar production into a single point of interconnection and file through the utility to give you credit for all of your meters on site?

**Answer:** Yes, you may propose aggregating solar production into a single point of interconnection and file through the utility to give the school district credit for all of our meters on-site?

5. **Question:** We saw that the schools were on TOU-2 and 3 billing rates which could be significantly reduced by utilizing battery storage. Would you be open to using batteries for your schools?

**Answer:** Yes, we would be open to using batteries for our schools' sites.

6. **Question:** Would there be any interest in EV charge stations at the schools while the canopy's are being installed?

**Answer:** No, there is no interest in EV charge stations at the school site.

7. **Question:** Do contractor's need to be pre-qualified to bid on this project?

**Answer:** Since this is a PPA project, there is no need for bidders to be prequalified.
